
CHAPTER 17: CHARTS OF THE ROLLS AND CRANNS AND THEIR SYMBOLS

Now that we have covered all of the rolls and cranns in depth, here are two charts summarizing the symbols for these ornaments and what they mean.

The first chart is organized by “class,” i.e. the long rolls, the short rolls, the long cranns, and the short cranns. *Pay close attention to the varying durations of the notes that appear under the symbols.*

The second chart is organized by duration of ornament in eighth-note beats, i.e. the three-beat ornaments, the two-beat ornaments, the one-beat ornaments. Note that:

- The symbols for the three-beat ornaments all appear over dotted quarter notes.
- The symbols for the two-beat ornaments all appear over regular quarter notes.
- The symbols for the one-beat ornaments all appear over eighth notes.
